Cabernet Sauvignon from Washington's Red Mountain Honors Family Friend

The Atkins' created the wine to raise awareness for this hereditary neurological brain disorder affecting over 30,000 people in the US. Chuck comments, "HD is debilitating -- it removes a person's ability to walk, talk, think and reason, and is eventually fatal. Through his struggle, David taught us how to look for the bright moments in life and look for the best in people. With each bottle we honor David's memory and come closer to finding a cure from the research these donations will help fund."

Brenner's Blend is sourced from Kiona Vineyard located in Washington's Red Mountain AVA. It retails for \$60 and is available on the winery's website, www.5PointsCellars.com. For those who want to further support this cause, today is "National Call In Day". HDSA is asking people to call their elected officials to educate them about the Huntington Disease Parity Act (S. 648/H.R. 718), which would make it easier for HD family members to obtain Social Security Disability benefits while eliminating the two year waiting period for Medicare.
